Also included is the development and gradual introduction of the use of a Pavement Management System (PMS) (excel based) in order to prioritise projects/programmes for funding. The monitoring and evaluation of road maintenance works will be conducted in order to attain the “value for money” principle. The appointment further includes the provision of technical capacity building by means of direct skills transfer and training.
