



The project is located at Oranjemund Airport, a fenced off Aerodrome and Logistics Facility situated 7 km south of Oranjemund Town. Oranjemund Airport lies within the Sperrgebiet National Park, an area well known for its rich deposits of diamonds which have been mined since 1908 and are continued to be mined today.

This project entails a condition assessment report, submitted during August 2017 and subsequent recommended remedial works including the resurfacing of airside facilities and extension of runway 02-20 at Oranjemund Airport

The recommended remedial construction work was phased into the following:

Phase 1: Resurfacing on taxiway Delta and joint repair on the concrete apron, as well as preparation works to use taxiway Delta as a temporary runway.

Phase 2: Resurfacing on runway 02-20 and the taxiway links, as well as the extension of runway 02-20.

Phasing of the construction was required to ensure that a functional runway is available at all times for Aerodrome Operations during the
